Our ongoing sustainability strategy is about understanding our impacts on our environment while enhancing the lives of our employees, local community and, most of all... our guests.

### Here's just a sample of the steps we've taken...

- Using low voltage lighting in all guest rooms
- Recycling waste
- Reducing electricity usage
- Using low flow showerheads and toilets
- Donating unused food to local charities
- Low voltage light fixtures that allow compact fluorescents are in all guest rooms.
- Recycling of all office paper and all cardboard
- All green waste is kept separate in a designated dumpster
- Old paint is donated to charities for re-use.
- Utilize frequency drive motors on our condenser pumps to reduce electricity usage.
- Recycling of tennis ball cans during tournaments: up to 480 cans per event.
- Donated used tennis balls to schools, care facilities and other facilities.
- Unused food is donated weekly to a charity designated by the Community Food Bank.
- Recycle bins available in public areas throughout the resort.
- Provide Paper bags in guestrooms designated for recyclable materials.
- Low flow showerheads and commodes.
- Irrigation and ground lighting all on timers.
- Donating cooking oil and grease for use as bio-diesel fuel.
